FACILITY: Rockland Community College is an indoor 6 lane 25 yard pool.

SESSIONS: Session 1: Saturday, October 18, 2014 – Warm Up 7:30 to 8:15 AM, 8:15 AM Start time

FORMAT: This is a timed final meet.

The meet will be deck seeded.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.

Age on **October 17, 2015** will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY SWIMMERS:

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special

consideration.

The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior

to the competition.

ENTRIES:

Swimmers may compete in 4 individual events and one relay. NT's will not be accepted. The host

club reserves the right to enter their swimmers with NT's.

All entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Teams will be considered accepted when the host club accepts the entries The host club must stay within the four hour per session rule. All received entries will be confirmed within 48 hours. Emailed Hy-Tek entry file is preferred. If sending by mail, entries should be sent on disk. A master sheet must accompany all entries

1: All invited teams will be givenpriority on a first come/first served basis. All other interested teams please

email the BG26608@HOTMAIL.COM and will be entered in the order received within the timelines.

2: The final entry deadline for this meet is October 11, 2015

An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you

do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

ENTRY FEE: An entry fee of \$6.00 per individual event and \$10.00 per relay must accompany the entries.

Payment must be received by October 11, 2015 for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail

entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

WARM-UP: The host club reserves the right to assign lanes for warm up based on the size of the meet. If lanes

are not assigned the first 30 minutes will be general warm up. Lanes 1 and 6 for pace and all other

lanes may be assigned by the meet director's discretion. No diving will be allowed accept in

designated sprint lanes. All swimmers must be supervised by a coach.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than

7:50 AM. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events scratches and which swimmers will not

be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA

Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not

possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 6th place in each event. Awards will be awarded by age for all

age groups, i.e. 6, 7, 8, 9/10

RULES: The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

SAFETY: Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-

ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules. "Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure

compliance with this requirement"

WATER DEPTH: USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measured for a

distance of 3 feet 31/2 inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls."

1.0 meter = 4 feet 6 inches, 5 meters = 13 feet
