SESSIONS: 1 Session. Warm-ups at 7:45am - Meet starts at 8:30 am

FORMAT: All events are timed finals. Slow to fast standard pre-seed seeding.

Metropolitan Association scratch rules will be in effect for this meet.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.

Age on October 9, 2016 will determine age for the entire meet.

No Time or NT is not acceptable.

DISABILITY SWIMMERS:

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special consideration. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any

disability prior to the competition.

ENTRIES: Limit of 5 individual events for the session.

Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis.

Meet will be run using Hy-Tek's Meet Manager. All entries must be in yards, NTs will not be accepted.

All entries must be sent in Team Manager format.

DEADLINE:

- 1: Metro LSC teams will be given priority on a first come/first served basis. Metro teams entries must be received by **September 25, 2016.**
- 2: The final entry deadline for this meet is October 2, 2016

3: Metro entries received between **September 1 and October 2** and all entries from other LSCs will be

entered in the order they were received, as space allows.

An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you do

not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

ENTRY FEE:

An entry fee of \$5 per individual even must accompany the entries.

Make check payable to: NDAC.

Payment must be received by **October 5, 2016** for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

WARM-UP: Assigned warm-up procedures will be in effect.

SCRATCHES:

Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events scratches

and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES:

In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: Events will be scored as following:

6&Under, 8&Under, 10& Under., 12&Under. Ribbons or bag tags for Places 1-6.

The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

SAFETY:

Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any

swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.

"Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being

proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal

guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement"

WATER DEPTH:

Turn end: The water depth at 1.0 meter from wall is 4 feet and at 5.0 meters it is 4.5 feet Block end: The water depth at 1.0 meter from wall is 13 feet and at 5.0 meters it is 12 feet
