Age on **December 9th**, **2017** will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY SWIMMERS:

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special

consideration.

The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability

prior to the competition.

ENTRY FEE: An entry fee of \$10 surcharge per individual athlete must accompany the entries.

Individual Events are \$5.00/Relays are \$10.00. Make check payable to: "Islanders Aquatics." Payment must be received by 11/05/17 for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

WARM-UP: General, USA Swimming Warm-Up rules apply; there will be 2 pace lanes & 2 sprint lanes

available for teams to use during both prelim & final sessions at the discretion of the meet

director and meet management staff.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later

than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual

events scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid

USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who

do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

RULES: The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

> The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

SAFETY: All swimmers must wear footwear upon leaving the pool area.

> Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules. "Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to

ensure compliance with this requirement"

WATER DEPTH: USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measured

for a distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls."
