

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.

No "Deck Registrations" will be accepted

Age on June 17th will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special

SWIMMERS: consideration.

The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior

to the competition.

ENTRIES: Swimmers are allowed only 3 individual events and 1 relay per day.

Entries will be cut by team in order to maintain Metro swimming guidelines.

DEADLINE: Entries must be received by: June 2, 2017. Metro Teams may enter prior to May 20, 2017

An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you

do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

ENTRY FEE: An entry fee of \$5.00 per individual event and \$10.00 per Relay event must accompany the entries.

Payment must be received by **entry deadline** for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

WARM-UP: Lane assignments will be posted, if necessary prior to each warm up session

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than

30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events

scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA

Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not

possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: A distinctive medal will be given to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places. Ribbons for places 4 through 8.

High Point awards will be given to top three individuals in each age division and top three teams.

RULES: The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

SAFETY: Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-

ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any

swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.

"Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being

proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When

unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal

guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement"
