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LOCATION: Nassau County Aquatic Center, Eisenhower Park, East Meadow, Long Island, NY 11554

FACILITY: 10 lane, 25 yd pool with 2 meter minimum depth. Colorado timing System, scoreboard readouts, Hy-Tex Meet Manager.

The pool **has not** been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4)

Session 111: Sunday, January 14, 2018 (8&un) (13/14) (open) warmup:7:00AM, start, 8:00AM
Session 1V: Sunday, January 14, 2018, (9/10), (11/12) warmup: 1:00PM, start: 2:00PM

FORMAT: Timed Final Events. The meet will be deck seeded. Entries are run using Hy-Tek MM.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.
All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.
“Deck Registrations” will NOT be accepted
Age on **January 13, 2018** will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY SWIMMERS: Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special consideration. The athlete (or the athlete’s coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.

ENTRIES: Athletes are limited to 3 events and 1 relay per session, Entries will be entered in the order received. If needed, entries will be cut by time, and you will be noticed by email.
NT’s not accepted.

DEADLINE: Metro LSC teams will be given priority on a first come/first served basis. Metro teams entries must be received by **December 28, 2017**. The final entry deadline for this meet is January 3, 2018. Metro entries received between December 28, 2017 and January 3, 2018 and all entries from other LSC’s will be entered in the order they were received and as space allows. An email confirming receipt of entries will be sent out. Please contact Meet Director if you do not

receive a report within 2 days of your original email.

ENTRY FEE:

An entry fee of \$**5.00** per individual even and \$10.00 per relay must accompany the entries. Make check payable to: **Nu-Finmen Swimming**.

Payment must be received by **January 12, 2018** for email entries. Payment must be included with all meet entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

WARM-UP:

General warmup with assigned lanes will be distributed each session along with scratch sheets. Sprint lanes and General lanes will be available for the remaining 10 minutes of warmup.

SCRATCHES:

Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES:

In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS:

Individual awards: custom ribbons 1st – 10th, relays: 1st – 3rd places. High point awards for each age group (male/female). Points awarded thru' 6th place, (no points awarded out of age group). Awards that are not picked up by end of meet will not be mailed.

RULES:

The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.
The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet.
The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

SAFETY:

All swimmers must wear footwear upon leaving the pool area. Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules. **“Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer’s legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement”**

WATER DEPTH:

USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measured for a distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls."
"[Click and Input water Depth at 1 meter and at 5 meters]"

- AUDIO/VISUAL STATEMENT:** Use of Audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms, or behind the blocks.
 "Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue(pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) anytime athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present."
- DECK CHANGING:** Deck changing is prohibited.
- ADMISSION:** \$7.00 per person, per session 10 & over / programs - \$3.00 each
- MERCHANTS:** Food available in designated areas. A concession stand is operated by Nassau County Aquatic Center. No glass bottles allowed on pool deck.
- PARKING:** Ample free parking is available in the park.
- DIRECTIONS:** From Verrazano Narrows Bridge & Kennedy Airport:
 Follow signs to Belt Parkway/Long Island East. Take Belt Pkwy E. past Kennedy Airport. After Kennedy Airport stay in the left lane and look for signs to the Southern State Pkwy E. Take Southern State Pkwy E to Meadowbrook Pkwy N. to NY-24 Hempstead Turnpike (exit M4). On Hempstead Turnpike get in left lane. Make left at first light (Merrick Ave.), make right into Eisenhower Park.
 From Whitestone & Throgs Neck Bridge: Take Cross Island Pkwy S to exit 29, Grand Central Pkwy E. follow Grand Central Pkwy to Meadowbrook Pkwy S (Jones Beach) to NY-24 (exit M4) and follow directions to Eisenhower Park.
