The Foreign Athletes Who Train with USA Swimming Clubs page of the Foreign Athletes section of the Registration/Membership Manual has been updated:

Foreign Athletes Who Train with USA Swimming Clubs

When an athlete member of a FINA Federation wishes to come to the United States and train with a USA Swimming club, the foreign athlete does not have to become a USA Swimming member if the athlete will be training with the club for less than 30 days. USA Swimming's insurance will provide liability coverage for the athlete, the USA Swimming club and coach during this 30 day period; however, there will be no excess accident medical coverage for the foreign athlete.

If the athlete will be in the United States more than 30 days, training with a USA Swimming club and competing in USA Swimming meets, he/she must become a USA Swimming member.
